Port Augusta Special School Choir

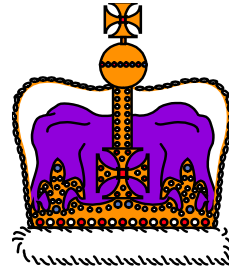
