### From the Principal ...

Welcome back to another school year and what a hectic start we have had. With two teaching staff members down, we have had to make use of our PRTs to help get us through. (PRTs – Permanent Relieving Teachers - normally used to cover absences for illnesses, or staff who are on training.)

Trudy replaces Kyoko, who took up the offer of a full time position with the Pt Augusta/Quorn Partnership group. Kyoko will have autism as a major focus for this year and she will be working with a number of different sites for 2023, before returning to us in 2024.

Alex is an experienced PRT, who brings a wealth of information and experiences to our school. He is currently filling the position vacated by Rhian, which will eventually be covered by Wendy. Wendy is currently away following surgery. We hope Wendy recovers soon and is back with us to take over the role of Reception/Year 1 teacher.

We also welcome Simon Cai and Sarah Bull.

Sarah replaces Kyoko, as this years' 0.8 NIT teacher. She will be working across the three reception / primary classes and Kath Smith retains her role as NIT teacher for the two secondary classes.

Both Sarah and Alex have slotted in really well and are a short-term solution to our staffing problem. Welcome, and thanks to you both for the excellent way you have joined in with our staff here at PASpS.

Welcome to Simon, who has settled in quite well and has a calming effect upon his students. Simon won his position last year and works with the junior primary school.

We had two teachers who left us rather late last year and these are the two positions I have had trouble filling. Twice I have advertised and twice we have had no applicants. This is a problem that is not unique to our school, it is happening across all schools in our region, and most schools in SA. The problem is in fact a national one; like every other industry and government department, Education is suffering staff shortages across the entire department.

I have now taken out an advertisement nationally to see if that has any impact on our staffing – one can only hope.

We also have Shauna with us as a PRT, who fills the hole vacated by Kelsey, who was fortunate to be offered a permanent position with another school in the district.

Welcome also to Usman Ghani who replaces Kristy Crabtree as our Finance Officer. Usman comes to us very experienced in the world of finance and accounting, but needs time to learn all about how to apply that in an educational setting. He is currently training with Katrina from PAWPS, thanks to David Laughton for allowing us to borrow Katrina whilst Usman settles in.

We hope to have our staffing issues sorted soon and full time people in place.

We have a lot of new changes that we hope become evident to parents as the year progresses.

Two of our SSOs, Keith and Deanna, have been given time and equipment to take our TV By Me program to the next level. They will be working toward more student content, with all commentary and content being included in the video. They will also be endeavouring to raise the profile of TV-By-Me with the wider school community.

Billie will be continuing her excellent work with the PODD System. She will work with students and staff initially and there are plans to maybe take this to parents and the wider community too.

Chelsea is ensuring all the students physical needs are catered for, by delivering a PE unit to Reception to Year 12 students. Teachers are on hand to ensure the students are learning PE curriculum and being assessed in appropriate ways. I have already received very positive reports of the PE program, and I acknowledge and thank Chelsea for the work she is doing for the benefit of our students.

There are lots of exciting things planned for our students such as swimming, aquatics and shopping expeditions. I think the Events Committee will be giving us details of a change to our end of year concert format for this year – more to come on that later.

Despite the messy start to the year with staffing, it has been an extremely positive start in terms of school culture — we began with T & D delivered by Anne Williams, Education Consultant from Adelaide, in which we looked at working effectively together, to achieve common goals and expectations. It set us up to be positive and motivated and as a result everyone is much more relaxed about their roles, and we are focusing on our well-being as well as achieving successful outcomes as a team.

A reminder that our Meet the Teacher Night is Wednesday 22 February. There will be a BBQ tea, meet the new staff and this will be followed by the AGM for the Governing Council at 6pm. We welcome you all to come along and get involved in your school. We have a very positive Governing Council and welcome new members to join us.
